REFUTATION OF PURPORTED LIST OF CUT-OFF POINTS FOR 2018/19 PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES SELECTION

The National Council for Higher Education Act (No. 15 of 2011) gives mandate to the Council to regulate, promote and coordinate education provided by higher education institutions. One of the functions of the Council is to harmonize the selection of students into the public universities.

NCHE would like to reiterate that in line with this function, it does **NOT** do the actual selection but the public universities themselves.

Therefore, NCHE would like to distance itself from a list circulating on social media purportedly showing district cut-off points for selection of students into public universities for 2018/19.

First of all, the selection of students has not even started as we are still receiving applications. Secondly and most importantly, this list is **BOGUS** and did **NOT** come from NCHE.

The general public is being advised to watch out against bogus lists circulating on social media, unless they have officially come from NCHE, which publicizes any information for the public in the two daily newspapers with nationwide circulation as well as on its website.
