REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION OF PROGRAMMES AND INSTITUTIONS

The National Council for Higher Education Act (No. 15 of 2010) gives mandate to the Council to regulate Higher Education Institutions in Malawi. In line with its mandate, the Council at its 33rd Ordinary Meeting held on 30th September 2021, made the following resolutions pertaining to registration and accreditation of Higher Education Institutions and programmes.

1.	International College of Business and Management (ICBM)	a) The Council registered International College of Business and Management (ICBM) as a higher education institution in Malawi. b) The Council registered the following six (6) programmes to be offered at ICBM: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Bachelor of Accountancy;2. Bachelor of Business Administration;3. Bachelor of Science in Marketing Management;4. Bachelor of Community Development;5. Bachelor of Science in Public Health; and6. Bachelor of Science in Information and Communication Technology.
2.	University of Lilongwe	The Council registered the following seven (7) additional programmes to be offered at University of Lilongwe: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Bachelor of Science in Marketing;2. Bachelor of Science in Procurement and Supply Chain Management;3. Bachelor of Science in Human Resource Management;4. Bachelor of Social Science in Social Work;5. Bachelor of Science in Community Development;

		6. Bachelor of Arts in Journalism; and 7. Master of Science in Applied and Development Economics.
3.	Deayang University	a) The Council registered the Master of Science in Data Management to be offered at Deayang University. b) The Council did not register Bachelor of Business Administration.
4.	Catholic University of Malawi	The Council accredited with conditions the Bachelor of Laws (Hons) programme to be offered at Catholic University of Malawi.
5.	Unicaf University	The Council accredited the PhD in Information Technology to be offered by Unicaf University.
6.	Marble Hill University	a) The Council accredited with conditions Marble Hill University (MHU) b) The Council accredited with conditions the following programmes to be offered at MHU: 1. Bachelor of Commerce in Business Administration; 2. Bachelor of Commerce in Human Resource Management; and 3. Bachelor of Commerce in Marketing.

The National Council for Higher Education further wishes to notify the general public that all private Higher Education Institutions are required to register with NCHE all new programmes and satellite centres before admitting students or commencing operations in those centres. The Council would like to assure the general public that it is doing everything possible to ensure that only registered Higher Education Institutions are operating and offering approved programmes. The Council is therefore urging all prospective students, parents and guardians to access list of all registered institutions and programmes in Malawi before enrolling.
